

PACKING FOR CAMP 2010

What should I take to Children's Camp at Mt. Hope Campground?

- Bible
- Sleeping bag or blankets
- Pillow
- Wash clothes & towels
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, etc.)
- Flashlight
- Garbage bag (for dirty clothes)
- Jacket for Rain
- Swimsuits w/t-shirt (girls—modest)
- Sturdy shoes (preferably tennis shoes)
- Extra pair of shoes in case others get wet
- Suntan lotion

* Money is not needed for any campers at Mount Hope. We have a concession stand where children receive a snack free of charge. Please do not send money.

** In case there is an emergency and you need to reach your child on the telephone, you may call Mount Hope Campground at (606)-849-2429. This number is for emergencies only. The location of the campground is at Rt. 156 off Rt. 32 between Morehead and Flemingsburg.

2010 CAMP FORMS CHECKLIST

1. Forms must be COMPLETE.
2. When form says "Signature of Parent/Legal Guardian," the forms **MUST BE SIGNED BY PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.**
3. The "Emergency Medical Treatment Statement" **MUST BE NOTARIZED.**
4. All campers and Junior Counselors in Training (teen C.I.T.'s) must be checked for head lice before they arrive at camp. Anyone with a contagious illness will have to return home for treatment. (See Camper Health Policy.)

Taking care of the above items prior to the first day of camp will make registration stress-free and will make the first day of camp everything it should be—**THE BEGINNING OF A GREAT WEEK!**
